1. Admit that you have sinned.

2. Acknowledge each of the sins committed, and be willing to turn away from them all.

3. Then say the prayer below.

**You can pray in your own words, but ensure that you humbly confess your sins.*

Be specific about the sin(s) you committed. Mention each one, as you pray. Nothing is hidden from God (Jeremiah 23:24).

Dear Father: I confess that I strayed from Your fold and went back to the world. Please forgive me for my sins (State the sins to acknowledge them). I want to come back to You. I rededicate my life to You wholly, and promise to stay true. I thank You, Father for Your mercy and loving kindness; and for sending Jesus Christ to die for my sins. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.

1. Admit that you have sinned.

2. Acknowledge each of the sins committed, and be willing to turn away from them all.

3. Then say the prayer below.

**You can pray in your own words, but ensure that you humbly confess your sins.*

Be specific about the sin(s) you committed. Mention each one, as you pray. Nothing is hidden from God (Jeremiah 23:24).

Dear Father: I confess that I strayed from Your fold and went back to the world. Please forgive me for my sins (State the sins to acknowledge them). I want to come back to You. I rededicate my life to You wholly, and promise to stay true. I thank You, Father for Your mercy and loving kindness; and for sending Jesus Christ to die for my sins. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.
