That said, a person who claims to have received Him may very well do the turning directly or

indirectly, when they reject His Lordship altogether. He or she is then said to have left the Faith by choice. Jesus Christ said that not everyone who says they believe and follow Him will make it to Heaven. unless they do the will of God the Father (Matthew 7:21-27).
